# Fugro Supports Ocean Sustainability Through Seabed 2030





This issue's Good Neighbor features Fugro's industry leading role in The Nippon Foundation-GEBCO Seabed 2030 Project.

Fugro is leading the marine survey industry in support for Seabed 2030, a collaborative project between The Nippon Foundation and GEBCO that aims to inspire the complete

mapping of the world's oceans by the year 2030. Fugro, a leading offshore surveying company headquartered in the Netherlands, is contributing bathymetry data acquired from its vessels during transits and from select projects where data sharing has been allowed. "Currently, less than 20 percent of the world's oceans have been mapped using modern survey techniques," stated David Millar, Fugro's Government Accounts Director for the Americas and member of the GEBCO Guiding Committee. "By enhancing our shared understanding of the world's oceans through a project like Seabed 2030, we will be better able to protect vulnerable coastal communities while sustainably developing valuable ocean resources needed to help meet the world's energy needs."

In-transit crowdsourced bathymetry contributions and working with clients to investigate how existing data might be shared are just a couple of ways that Fugro participates in the project. Additionally, Fugro demonstrates its leadership and commitment by urging others with offshore survey expertise, resources and data to get involved. Fugro asks the same of the IAGC membership.
